

## **Trail Ridge Men's Golf Club – New local rule to take effect on March 27, 2019**

This rule is for regular Wednesday club play and is not an RCSCW rule.

A player may elect to take stroke-and-distance relief if a ball is out of bounds, lost or with reasonable certainty that it is.

The local rule option can be taken with a TWO-STROKE penalty.

Determine where your ball went out of bounds or likely lost.

Find the nearest fairway edge (no closer to the hole).

Keeping that point of loss or OOB and the fairway point equal distance from the pin, a relief area is 2- club lengths within that area (yes, in the fairway).

NOTE: If you choose to hit a provisional ball from the tee and discover that your first ball is indeed OOB or lost, this option does not exist. The provisional ball is in play.
