#### Membership Report

As of 5/11/2021 we have 227 members. The years budget was based on 250 so we have some work to do in recruiting but also expect some improvement when the Fall arrives and, in particular, the Canadian members return.

A discussion was had regarding establishing Blue and Green Tee games for those wanting to play from those tees. It is expected that a significant number of players would leave their current clubs and transfer to TR if we did the above. Time will tell.

#### Handicap Committee

We discussed the need to be able to verify scores posted, or not, on days other than Wednesdays with Pat O'Hara. Nick Ferri has access to the date played/score data on the Peer Review portion of the AGA website. We will contemplate the need and value of doing that. Valid Handicaps are the hallmark of our game.

#### Tournaments

It was agreed that we should replace the Gold Tee game scheduled this month with a "move up one tee" event. White tee players move to Gold, Gold to Red, etc.

## Greens/ Maintenance

## Old Business
